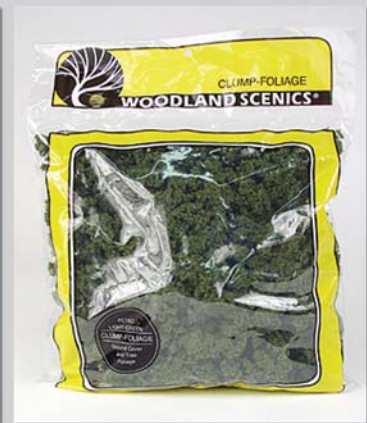


Product: *Twigs & Foliage*

## Tips

- Be on the lookout for twigs during your normal commute to and from work or school
- Twigs with buds on them add a nice bit of variety
- Foliage will dry and crumble, seal it with a flexible brush-on sealer to preserve it for gameplay
- Keep foliage completely sealed (ziplock) at all times or it will dry out and be unusable
- Super white glue can be used to seat foliage. Apoxie Sculpt works well to stand twigs upright.

## Application

- Obtain a blank base.
- Glue or Apoxie Sculpt a twig laying on the ground or standing upright to the base. Allow to dry.
- Prime in black.
- Dry brush the twig with browns and greys to simulate a real-life effect.
- Paint any other bits and pieces you may have placed on the base as well.
- Apply a “pinch” of foliage to a dab of super or white glue. Allow to dry.
- Seal the base in a brush-on matte sealer of choice.

## My Comments

Woodland Scenics has a good variety of foliage although it's a bit pricey. Your local craft store should also carry a variance in foliage colors as well. I found some real cool dead looking foliage at Michaels. A huge bag was around \$4 or so. These two products work well together when they are placed around one another because they resemble dead trees and bushes growing around the dead tree just like I see in the mountains. I have used it on my snow bases to simulate a late fall snow before (when the leaves are turning color). ArkenTyre from brushthralls.com put it best when he said told me one day that even if you can't paint that having a good base will make your model look better. That's so true, do it one day and compare on your own stuff.
