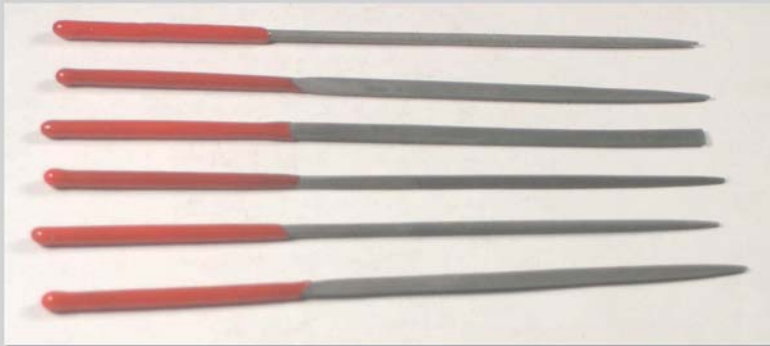
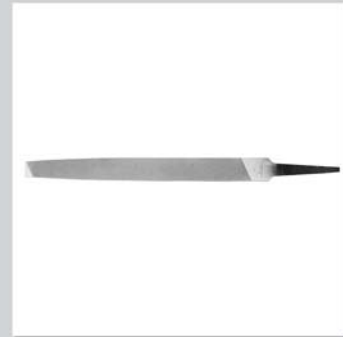

Needle Files



Mill File

Tips

- You will need at least three Needle Files (1 round, 1 flat, 1 triangle)
- One Mill file should last a lifetime when used on models only
- Carbon cut Needle Files files are really too coarse even at fine grit for models
- Diamond cut Needle Files are OK for models
- The higher the grit the finer or smoother the surface will be after filing

Application

- After the flash has been cut away, use the fine Needle Files to smooth out the surface
- Use the Needle Files to smooth out casting lines on the model
- Use the Mill file to bore down heavy chunks of metal that you can't cut or scrape away
- Make consistent swipes over the model to ensure no file marks are left behind
- File often in a circular motion, especially when using the circle and triangle Needle Files

The Mill file is something I picked up that I use when transporting painted figs from the bottle cap bases to the permanent sculpted base. I use it to file down the excell metal under the feet of jacks and troops as it only takes about 5 swipes to bore down heavy chunks of metal. This way I have a nice flat foot to pin to the sculpted base.
