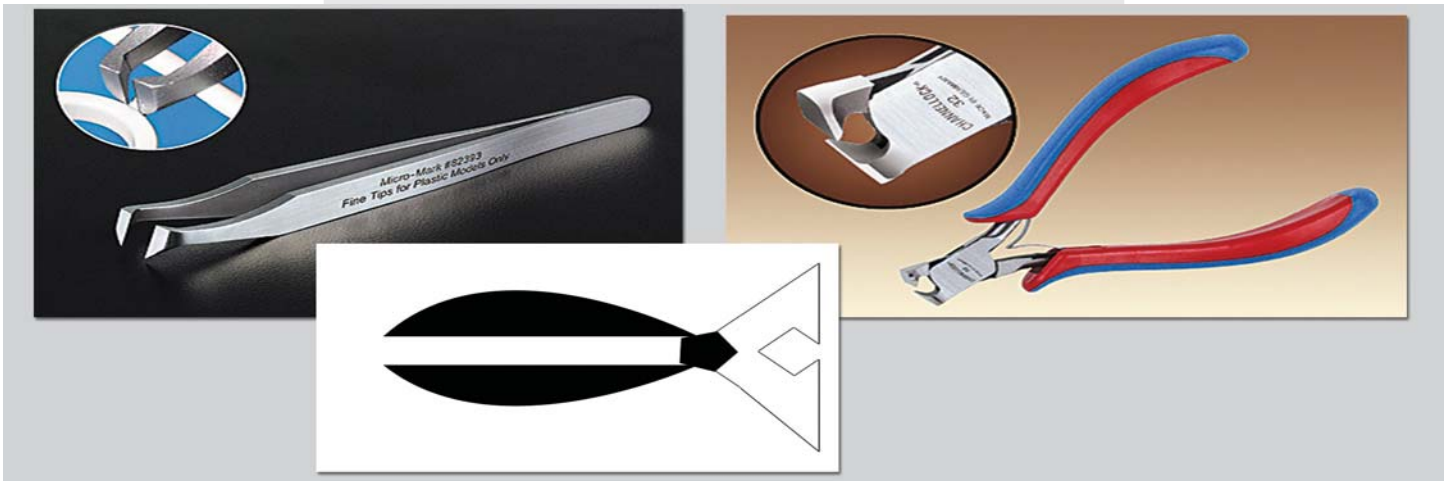


Product: *Flush End Pliers & Despruing Tweezers*

Tips

- Use Despruing Tweezers on smaller flash areas only as they are not that strong
- Look at your pliers before you buy to ensure the cut area is clean, razor edged and flush
- Be careful not to cut brass rods with these tools as they can damage the edge
- Flush End pliers are perfect for cutting plastistrut or plasticard in small chunks

Application

- Cut away “flash” moulding that accumulates during model manufacturing
- Modify models by cutting apart limbs, heads, weapons and replacing with your own creation
- Cut away debris from your glue applicator or to cut a new hole in your Z-ends
- Cut an area away from dried moulding compound instead of sculpting a straight line
- Crimp notches in armour and weapons instead of sculpting them in manually
